CHALLENGE DESCRIPTION

Our Gulf waters have been designated a Hope Spot. This means that it is a special place that is critical to the health of the oceans, and the oceans are critical to the health of the planet. The ocean may seem like such an endless amount of water that it is too big for us to affect, but it's not. The land and the ocean are part of one giant system - our Earth. What we do on the land affects our waters (and vice versa). We spend most of our time on land, thus the key to keeping our waters and the animals that live in them healthy is ensuring that human actions, even those on land, are sustainable.

The Blue-Green Connections Hope for the Future Award will be given to the submission that best answers the below questions. Get creative!

- Why is the ocean is important to you and to everyone?
- How do our human actions affect our waters positively or negatively?
- How would your idea for changing our everyday behavior help make or keep our Gulf waters cleaner and healthier for us and the many animals that call it home?

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be a student in the Tampa Bay area as of the application submission date (homeschooled, in-person, and virtual school all acceptable)
- Complete the downloadable application form and submit with parent or guardian signature
- Create a submission (Word, PowerPoint, PDF, image, audio or video format) that answers the bulleted questions above.
- Upload your submission and the application to

 2020 with the appropriate titles (see page3). Projects may be submitted individually or
 by group.

AWARDS

There will be up to 18 \$100 awards granted for this project in addition to public recognition

- 15 students/groups with the most creative and influential projects each win \$100
- 3 teachers with the most participants each win \$100. This includes teachers from elementary, middle or high schools, after school programs, camps, homeschoolers, etc.
- There will be public recognition of winning students, teachers and participating schools
- Select winning projects will be displayed virtually and in Tarpon Springs Aquarium
- Your family, friends, and community all win as they are educated about the Hope Spot
